U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES

(For the month of May 2015)

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of May, 2015 is highlighted below.

A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :

(i) Major Works completed during the month of May, 2015:

- Providing 40mm thick dense graded bituminous macadam and 20mm thick mix seal surface (MSS type) by sencer paver finish on four lane road from Nagoa junction to Vanakbara, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 2.77 Crore.
- Construction of protection wall with pathway along seashore of Nagoa beach from opp. Police station to Entrance gate near Canga Sagar at Nagoa, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 0.45 Crore.
- Providing of Furnishing items to the Govt. Circuit House, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 0.21 Crore.

B. <u>Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during</u> the month of May, 2015:

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of May, 2015 is as follows:
