### NOTIFICATION

No. 1/4-22/91/DMC/98-99

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sub-Section (1) of Section 307 read with Section 184, 143 and 323 of the Daman and Diu Municipalities (Amended) Regulation, 1994 and all other powers enabling in that behalf, the Daman Municipal Council after obtaining previous approval of the Government hereby make the following amendment to the Goa, Daman and Diu Municipalities, Building Model Bye-laws and Zonning Regulation, 1971 published in the Official Gazette Series –I, No.19, dated 05.08.1971 and adopted by Daman Municipal Council on 26.08.1972. Published in Local daily News Paper, the objection were called and considered. Therefore following amendment is made.

SHORT TITLE

This amendment shall be called "The Goa, Daman and Diu Municipalities Building Model Bye-laws and Zonning Regulation, 1971 (1st Amendment of Daman Municipal Council, 1999).

2. APPLICATION

The amendment shall apply to Municipal Area of Daman District from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

3. AMENDMENT OF BYE-: LAWS 38 (I) RESIDENTIAL Zone (R-1)

If no light and ventilation is to be taken from the side of the building, above mentioned set backs can only be relaxed if the building is taken right upto the boundary.

In case of row housing building on corner plot shall further be set back of such a distance from the side street as may be suitable to meet the needs of traffic.

For group housing, the coverage and floor area ratio will be as above. The maximum floor area ratio, however for plots exceeding 5000 sq. mts. in area can be 400.

The set backs of buildings, garages and other structures will have to be approved in each case but normally the distance to be left from the boundary of the plot will be as per requirements mentioned above, and the distance between two buildings within the plot, if belonging to the same owner should be not less than one third of the mean heights of the two buildings involved, or three meters which ever is more. However garages, out houses, fuel stores and the like is not more than one story height may be permitted at a minimum distance of 3.0 mts. From the main structure. The plans would further be required to indicate adequate facilities for playing areas, parking, garaging and servicing within the plot.

#### INISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT & FORESIS

DIFICATION UNDER SECTION 3(1) ECTION 3(2)(v) OF THE ENVIRONMENT TECTION) ACT, 1986 AND RULE 5(3)(d)
ENVIRONMENT (PROTECTION) RULES,
DECLARING COASTAL STRETCHES AS COASTAL REGULATION ZONE (CRZ) AND REGULATING ACTIVITIES IN THE CRZ.

#### New Delhi, the 19th February, 1991

50, 114(E).—Whereas a Notification under Sec-= 3(1) and Section 3(2)(v) of the Environment declaration of Constal Stretches as Constal Regu-Zone (CRZ) and imposing restrictions on mastries, operations and processes in the CRZ was seed field vide S.O. No. 944 (E) dated 15th Decem-1990.

And whereas all objections received have been diffe considered by the Central Government;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred Que (d) of sub-rule (3) of Rule 5 of the En-(Protection) Rules, 1986, and all other vesting in its behalf, the Central Government beachy declares the coastal stretches of seas, bays, ares creeks, rivers and backwaters which are enced by tidal action (in the landward side) upto metres from the High Tide Line (HTL) and the d between the Low Tide Line (LTL) and the HTL Coastal Regulation Zone; and imposes with effect the date of this Notification, the following resmetons on the setting up and expansion of industries. Zone (CRZ) For purposes of this Notification, the Heal Tide Line (ITTL) will be defined as the line which the highest high tide reaches at spring

The distance from the High Tide Line to which the proposed regulations will apply case of rivers, creeks and backwaters may be ded on a case by case basis for reasons to be while preparing the Coastal Zone Manage-the Plans (referred to below); however, this distance not be less than 100 metres or the width of the met, river or backwater whichever is less.

#### 2. Prohibited Activities:

The following activities are declared as prohibited the Coastal Regulation Zone, namely :

- setting up of new industries and expansion of existing industries, except those directly related to water front or directly needing foreshore facilities;
- manufacture or handling or storage or disposal of hazardous substances as specified in the Notifications of the Government & India in the Ministry of Environment & Forests No. S.O. 594(E) dated 28th July, 1989, S.O. 966(E) dated 27th November,

1989 and GSR 1037(E) dated 5th Decem-

- Department of Environment, Forests & Wildlife) (iii) Setting up and expansion of fish processing units including warehousing (excluding hatchery and natural fish drying in permitted areas);
  - (iv) setting up and expansion of units mechatnisms for disposal of waster and effluents, except facilities required for discharging treated effluents into the water course with approval under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974; and except for storm water drains;
  - (v) di charge of untreated wastes and effluents from Industries, cities or towns and other human settlements. Schemes shall be implemented by the concerned authorities for phasing out the existing practices, if any, within a reasonable time period not exceeding three years from the date of this noti-
  - (vi) dumping of city or town waste for the purposes of landfilling or otherwise; the existing practice, if any, shall be phased out within a reasonable time not exceeding three years from the date of this Notification;
  - (vii) dumping of ash or any wastes from thermal power stations ;
  - (viii) land reclamation, hunding or disturbing the natural course of rea water with similar obstructions, except those required for control of coastal erosion and maintenance or cleasing of waterways, channels and ports and for prevention of sandbars and also except for tidal regulators, storm water drains and structures for prevention of salinity ingress and for sweet water recharge;
    - (ix) mining of sands, tocks and other substrata materials, except those rare minerals not available outside the CRZ areas;
    - (x), harvesting or drawal of ground water and construction of mechanisms therefor within 200 m of HTL; in the 200 m to 500 m zone it shall be permitted only when done manually through ordinary wells for drinking, horticulture, agriculture and fi-heries;
      - construction activities in ecologically sensitive areas as specified in Annexure-I of this Notification;
    - any construction activity between the Low Tide Line and High Tide Line except facilities for carrying treated effluents waste water discharges into the sea, facilities for carrying sea water for cooling purposes, oil, gas and similar pipelines and facilities es ential for activities permitted under this Notification ; and
  - (xiii) dressing or altering of sand dunes, hills, natural features including landscape changes

for beautification, recreational and other such purpose, except as permissible under

## 3. Regulation of Permissible Activities :

All other activities, except those prehibited in para 2 above, will be regulated as under :

- (1) Clearance shall be given for any activity within the Coastal Regulation Zone only if it requires water front and foreshore facilities.
- (2) The following activities will require environmental clearance from the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, namely:
- Construction activities related to Defence requirements for which foreshore facililies are essential (e.g. slipways, jetties etc.); except for classified component of defence projects a separate procedure shall be (Residential buildings, office buildings, building hospital complexes, workshops shall not come within the definition of operational requirements except in very special cases and hence shall not normally be permitted
- (ii) Operational constructions for ports and harbours and light houses requiring water frontage; jetties wharves, ways etc. (Residential buildings & office buildings shall not come within the definition of operational activities except in very special cases and nence shall not normally be permitted in the CRZ);
- (iii) Thermal power plants (only foreshore facilities for transport of raw materials facili-ties for in-take of cooling water and outfall for discharge of treated waste water
- (iv) All other activities with investment exceeding rupees five crores.
- The coastal States and Union Territory, Administrations shall prepare, within a (3) (i) period of one year from the date of this Notification. Coastal Zone Management Plans identifying and classifying the CRZ areas within their respective territories in accordance with the guidelines given in Annexures-I and II of the Notification and obtain approval (with or without modifi-cations) of the Central Government in the Ministry of Environment & Forests:
- (ii) Within the framework of such approved all development and activities within the CRZ other than those covered in para 2 and para 3(2) above shall he regulated by the State Government. ### ANNEXURE I

### COASTAL AREA CLASSIFICATION AN DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS

Classification of Coastal Regulation Zone:

6(1) For regulating development coastal stretches within 500 metres of High Line of the landward side are classified into categories, namely :

## Category I (CRZ-T):

- (i) Areas that are ecologicall, Areas that are ecologicall, sensitive and portant, such as national parks/mar parks, sanctuaries, reserve foreste, wild habitats, mangroves, cora scoral reefs, as close to breeding and spawning grounds fish and other marine life, areas of control of the space standing natural beautylhistorical heritareas, areas rich in genetic diversity, ar likely to be inundated due to rise in level consequent upon global warming a such other areas as may be declared by Central Government or the concerned thorities at the State Union Territory level from time to time.
