Timing of National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme :

Monday to Friday : 9.00 am to 1.00 pm and 2.30 pm to 5.00 pm Saturday : 9.00 am to 1.00 pm.

Standards of Services :

The service for prevention and control of VBD provides as per the direction of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare and The Directorate of NVBDCP, Delhi.

Routine work

- 1. <u>Anti larval:-</u> Under this activities the regular anti larval activities are carried out by Daily Wages workers by spraying insecticide in permanent and temporary water collected area and breeding palaces to minimize the mosquito menaces. As per the weekly schedule.
- <u>Anti adult activities :-</u> Under this activities the indoor residual spray as well as seasonal spray round with insecticide is carried out in the area which is more than two API and in the areas where positive cases are found. Two round 45 days in a year during transmission season.
- 3. **Fogging:** Fogging is carried out as an when the density on mosquito is increased.
- 4. <u>Supervision and Surveillance: -</u> Regular supervision and surveillance carried out in all 20 sub centre area by the supervisory staff of this office.
- 5. The month of June is observed as "Anti Malaria Month" every year from 1st June to 31st June in the UT. During the month awareness activities are carried out through Nukkad Natak, Banner, Poster, Health education etc.

Anti Dengue month is observed from 1st July to 31st July for Prevention and Control of Chikunguniya during the month also the above activities carried out in addition to sub centre wise Village Health & Sanitation Committee.

Elimination of lymphatic filariasis programme is carried since 2004 and the Department has achieved the elimination stage.
