

20. GOVERNMENT POLYTECHNIC

20.1 COURSES :

Government Polytechnic, Daman was established in October, 1989. The Institute was established to provide three years Diploma Courses in Chemical, Mechanical and Civil Engineering for the students of UT Administration of Daman and Diu with an intake capacity of 33 students in each course.

Diploma Courses at Government Polytechnic, Daman will run under Semester pattern and each term will be as per the dates prescribed by the Technical Examination Board, Gujarat.

The Institute has been established to prepare mid-level, supervisory manpower required by the industry by imparting training in theory, drawing and practical skills for three years.

The students after completing the courses are popularly called Diploma Engineers (Technicians) and they are employed in Govt. Departments as well as Private and Public Sector.

20.2 ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS :

The requirement for candidate seeking admissions to the courses are as under :

1. Must be a citizen of India
2. Passed SSC examination with English, Mathematics and Science from Gujarat SSC Board in a single sitting.
3. Must have resided in the UT of Daman and Diu for a minimum period of five years preceding the year of application.

20.4 PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION :

The application form enclosed in the prospectus may be obtained from the office of the Principal, Govt. Polytechnic, Daman on payment of Rs. 50/- in cash, at the cash counter and Rs. 75/- by Money Order, if required by post.

The candidate shall fill the form and indicate in the relevant column and choice of course in order of preference.

On the basis of application received, a merit list shall be prepared and the list shall be put-up on the notice board of the premises.

20.5 FEES :

The examination fee as prescribed by the Technical Examination Board, Gujarat shall have to be paid at the time of filling in the examination form / registration.

Students desirous of leaving the Institute under any circumstance will be entitled to get refund of the fees on submission of written application to the Principal stating reasons thereof.

20.6 RULES FOR ADMISSION :

i) Students shall be regular and punctual in attending classes, tutorials and submission of team work in various subjects. 75 % of attendance in theory and practicals, drawing and industrial training is compulsory.

ii) If any candidate who is offered admission does not pay the prescribed fees within the date specified in the Notice of offer of admission, the offer will be treated as cancelled and the seat will be offered to the next eligible candidate in the merit list. Even if a candidate pays the tuition fees but fails to join the Institution within fifteen days, the Principal may at his discretion, cancel the admission.

iii) The admission offered shall be cancelled if the Technical Examination Board declares that the candidate is not eligible and if any information supplied by the candidate in connection with his/her admission is at any time found to be incorrect, the candidate shall be liable to be dismissed and the fees paid shall be forfeited .
The decision of the Principal in this matter shall be final.
