Sealed Tender is hereby invited by Pollution Control Committee, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu, Daman from the interested MoEF recognized agencies/laboratories to carry out the Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Programme in the UT of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu. The details of the programme are as under:-

1.	Title	Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Programme in the Union Territory of Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu.
2.	Details of Programme	Sampling, Monitoring, Analysis and submission of Analysis report in the prescribed format on monthly basis
3.	No. of Monitoring Stations	06 (Six) - Three in Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Three in Daman as selected by Pollution Control Committee, DNH & DD.
4.	Monitoring Period	Twice a week 24 hourly at uniform interval sampling shall be done at 8 hours interval.(104 samples annually for one station)
5.	Parameters to be analyzed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Particulate Matter (size less than 10 μm) or PM_{10} $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$, Particulate Matter (size less than 2.5 μm) or $\text{PM}_{2.5}$ $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$, Sulphur Dioxide (SO_2) $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$, Nitrogen Dioxide (NO_2) $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$, Carbon Monoxide (CO) mg/m^3, Ammonia (NH_3) $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$, Ozone (O_3) $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$, Lead (Pb) $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$, Benzene (C_6H_6) $\mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$, Benzo (a) Pyrene (BaP)-particulate phase only ng/m^3, Arsenic (As) ng/m^3 and Nickel (Ni) ng/m^3. Any other parameter as specified/instructed by Pollution Control Committee from time to time.
6.	Data on Meteorological/Humidity, Temperature, Wind speed, Wind Direction, Rain fall etc of the concerned area need to be provided.	
7.	Duration of the Programme	Initially for a period of one year. However, if necessary it may be extended for further period.
8.	The rates quoted should be in accordance with the CPCB guidelines.

Notes:

- 1) The Bidder should quote the rate in lump sum in Indian rupees and must include all charges related to data collection, testing, etc inclusive of applicable taxes and no other charges apart from quoted rate on BOQ will be accepted.
- 2) Tender received after due date and time will not be considered.
- 3) The Tender fees is Rs. 1,000/- non refundable.
- 4) EMD is Rs. 50,000/- executed by way of Demand Draft only.
- 5) The Tender fees/EMD is paid through Demand draft drawn in favour of Pollution Control Committee, payable at Daman.
- 6) Successful bidder has to execute a Performance Security of 3% of the value of contract.

Eligibility Criteria for TPQA:


- 1) Registration of agency: Interested bidders having registration of company/firm/agency, registration Certificate and IT returns.

- 3) Material Testing Laboratory: The Bidder must have the best in field-testing and calibrated equipments and should have own material testing laboratory with required instrument/equipment and should have the approval/recognition of MoEF & CC, Govt. of India.
