- 2. At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all present and commenced the meeting.
- 3. The Minutes of the meeting of Daman Diu Coastal Zone Management Authority (DDCZMA) held on dated 06/04/2018 has been discussed and approved. However, the Collector, Diu informed and requested to send back the original files of the CRZ clearance applications/proposals placed before the DDCZMA for consideration in its meeting held 06/04/2018 for the finalization of cases.

The DDCZMA granted the permission to send back all the original files placed before DDCZMA in its meeting held on 06/04/2018 to Collector, Diu with the direction to keep a shadow copy of all files.

## AGENDA ITEM NO. 1. :DRAFT COASTAL ZONE MANAGEMENT PLAN MAPS OF DAMAN & DIU

The matter has been discussed and it has been decided that the technical issues raised by the general public on the CZMP Maps of Daman & Diu may be sent to NCSCM, Chennai for making necessary corrections.

## AGENDA ITEM NO. 2. :EROSION/ACCRETION MAP OF DAMAN & DIU

The DDCZMA has requested, the NCSCM, Chennai to share a copy of Shoreline Maps of Daman & Diu depicting erosion and accretion along the Coastal Areas.

The DDCZMA has provided copy of the Erosion/Accretion map to the Secretary (Tourism)/the Managing Director, ODIC/ the Chief Engineer, Public Works Department/ the Member Secretary, Planning & Development Authority/Collector, Diuto refer the map to identify the erosion prone areas and take up works related to check such erosion in shore/coastal areas of Daman & Diu for the improvement of the Coastal Areas and to allow beach formation along the shore. No additional stabilisation related works should be considered wherever accretion is taking place.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 3.: PROPOSAL FOR THE CRZ CLEARANCE FOR BEACH RESORT PROJECT " M/S SILVER WAVES RESORT & SPA, SURVEY NO. 16/1, 1 OF VILLAGE KATHIRIA, NANI DAMAN".

Application dated 23/05/2018 was received from Shri Jayanti D. Tandel, Daji Ni Wadi, Devka Road, Nani Daman for seeking post facto CRZ Clearance for Beach Resort Project "M/s Silver Waves Resort & Spa at Survey No. 16/1, 1 of Village Kathiria, Nani Daman" as per notification SO 1002(E) dated 6/03/2018

The matter was referred to the District Level CRZ Committee and in its Meeting held on 21/06/2018, the District Level CRZ Committee, Daman examined the proposal with available records and documents submitted by the applicant Shri Jayanti D. Tandel and observed that;

- a) The District Level Committee, Daman discussed the proposal at length and the facts were verified.
- b) The project falls under CRZ-II as per the notification dated 06/01/2011. The above mentioned activity is permitted vide notification SO 383(E) dated 04/02/2015.
- c) Therefore the Committee decided to recommend the proposal to DDCZMA, Daman & Diu. "

The District Level CRZ Committee, Daman has recommended the proposal and referred it to the DDCZMA for further action.

The DDCZMA examined the proposal with respect to **Annexure III** of the CRZ Notification dated 06/01/2011 read with notification No. SO 383(E) dated 04/02/2015 and the notification No. SO 1002(E) dated 6/03/2018 of Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, Government of India. The following amendment is made in the said notification No. SO 1002(E) dated 6/03/2018;

## "4.3 Post facto clearance for permissible activities,-

- (i) all activities, which are otherwise permissible under the provisions of this notification, but have commenced construction without prior clearance, would be considered for regularisation only in such cases wherein the project applied for regularization in the specified time and the projects which are in violation of CRZ norms would not be regularized;
- (ii) the concerned Coastal Zone Management Authority shall give specific recommendations regarding regularisation of such proposals and shall certify that there have been no violations of the CRZ regulations, while making such recommendations;
- (iii) such cases where the construction have been commenced before the date of this notification without the requisite CRZ clearance, shall be considered only by Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, provided that the request for such regularisation is received in the said Ministry by 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2018."

The DDCZMA discussed the proposal and found that the project proponent is seeking post facto CRZ clearance of the project as per Notification dated 6/03/2018. The Project Proponent had started construction activities after taking approval from the planning authorities, i. e Daman Municipal Council, but, they have not taken CRZ clearance till date. However, the committee found that the project developed is situated in the CRZ-II area and hence it is a permissible activity as per abovementioned Notifications and it can be forwarded to the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change for post facto CRZ clearance, subject to the compliances of the following conditions;

- a) Live fencing and barbed wire fencing with vegetative cover may be allowed around private properties subject to the condition that such fencing shall in no way hamper public access to the beach;
- b) No flattening of sand dunes shall be carried out;
- No permanent structures for sports facilities shall be permitted except construction of goal posts net posts and lamp posts;
- d) Construction of basement may be allowed subject to the condition that no objection certificate is obtained from the State Ground Water Authority to the effect that such construction will not adversely affect free flow of ground water in that area;
- e) The state Ground Water Authority shall take into consideration the guidelines issued by the Central Government before granting such no objection certificate;
- f) The quality of treated effluents, solid wastes, emissions and noise levels and the like, from the projects area must conform to the standards laid down by the competent authorities including the Central or State Pollution Control Board and under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986;
- g) Necessary arrangements for the treatment of the effluents and solid wastes must be made and it must be ensured that the untreated effluents and solid

wastes are not discharged into the water or on the beach; and no effluent or solid waste shall be discharged on the beach;

h) If the project involves diversion of forestland for non-forest purposes, clearance as required under the Forest(Conservation) Act, 1980 shall be obtained and the requirements of other Central and State Laws as applicable to the project shall be met with.

EXPANSION OF GOVERNMENT HOSPITAL, MARWAD AND CONSTRUCTION OF COLLEGE OF NURSING AND HOSTEL FOR NURSES.

A letter has been received by E-mail dated 20/06/2018 from the Director, Medical & Health Services, Daman & Diu informing that the Government Hospital which is at present 185 bedded District Hospital is being expanded to a 300 bedded multi-speciality hospital alongwith the College of Nursing and Hostel for nursing students.

The expansion of the hospital is proposed in the same venue where the present hospital is situated. The Department is in process of engaging a hospital consultant/architect for the entire expansion program. And it has been requested to give CRZ clearance to the said project.

The DDCZMA observed that the application has to be submitted in a proper format. Hence, it is decided to direct the concerned authorities to apply in proper format alongwith the supporting documents as per the Check list mentioned in CRZ Notification 2011 and it will be put up for CRZ Clearance in the next meeting.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
