## CIRCULAR

Sub: Ban on use of Lead stabilizer in manufacturing of Polyvinyl Chloride pipes

As per the Judgement dated 25<sup>th</sup> May 2017 passed by Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT), Principal Bench, New Delhi in the matter of Jan Sahyog Manch Vs. Union of India & Others (Original Application No. 477 of 2015) all the industrial units involved in manufacturing of Polyvinyl Chloride pipes are hereby directed to use alternate stabilizer instead of Lead, as there is ban on usage of Lead as stabilizer for manufacturing of Polyvinyl Chloride pipes.

In case of failure on the part of the Industrial unit to comply with the above referred direction, Pollution Control Committee Daman & Diu will initiate action as per the direction issued by the Hon'ble National Green Tribunal (NGT) by issuing closure directions to the defaulting industrial units which may be noted seriously.

Moreover, any citizen or organization of the UT of Daman & Diu can make complain to the Pollution Control Committee Daman & Diu against the defaulting industries.
