

M/s. Sunshine Laminator, Sr. no. 201, Gala no. 2 & 3, Village - Samarvani, Silvassa. was issued Consent to Establish for manufacturing of “ All types of plastic Lamination film sheets, woven roll, MG. paper sandwich bag, cutting, stitching Flexo printing – 600 MT/Ann (no other items).” under Water and Air act valid upto 30/06/2013. The activity falls under **Category-III**.

The unit has submitted application for grant of consent to Operate under Water and Air act on 08/01/2016 along with the following documents;

- Application form no. XIII under Water Act.
- Application form no. I under Air Act.
- Declaration giving details of capital investment including land, building and plant & machinery without description.
- Consent fees under water and air act for Rs. 7,500/-.
- Format installed Environmental Display sign board.
- Application for authorization to handle Hazardous Waste (form-I).
- Industry Data Sheet.
- Copy of Consent to Establish under Water and Air Act.
- Form-I of Recycled Plastic Manufacturing and Usage (Amendment) Rules, 2003 for grant of registration for manufacturing of plastic carry bags and containers.

Actual consent to operate fee is Rs.9610/- but unit had submitted Rs.7500/-.



The unit was inspected on 04/03/2016. At the time of inspection of the unit following observations were noted:


- Display sign board was not installed at the entrance gate of the unit.
- The unit was in operation at the time of inspection.
- Raw materials used in manufacturing process were Granules of PP, PE, LDPE and Inc.
- Products being manufactured were laminated film sheets, woven roll, paper sandwich & plastic bags.
- Manufacturing process involved in the unit was extrusion, cutting, stitching and printing.
- Machineries installed in the unit were exactly same as mentioned in the consent to establish application form.
- Housekeeping observed was good.
- Proper storage facilities were available for raw material and products.
- The unit is not significant to pollution potential. As there is no water used during any stage of process.
- The unit was availed with septic tank and sock pit for generated domestic waste water.

So, based upon the scrutiny of submitted documents, consent fee and observation during the inspection a quarry letter is prepared and placed in the file regarding submission of remaining consent to operate fee of Rs.2110 and installation of display sign board.
