Applications are invited from the students belonging to the minority communities notified by the Central Government under Section 2 (c) of the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992, who are pursuing higher education from Class XI upto Ph.D, including technical/vocational courses of Industrial Training Institutes/Industrial Training Centres (affiliated with NCVT) in Government school/college/institute or school/college/institute recognized by appropriate authority, for Post-Matric scholarship to be awarded by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India. Courses other than those listed under merit-cum-means scholarship scheme, would be covered under the Post-Matric scholarship scheme. The details of the Scheme and eligibility criteria may be inspected in the office of the Assistant Director of Education, Daman & Education Officer, Diu.



Subject:- Publishing of Advertisement by States/UTs to implement Post-matric Scholarship Scheme for the year 2012-13- allocation of Physical target under the scheme to students belonging to minority communities.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that Post-matric Scholarships Schemes is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme launched in the year 2007. Under the scheme Scholarships are awarded to the meritorious students from minority communities who have secured not less than 50% marks or equivalent grade in the previous final examination and the annual income of whose parents/guardian, from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2 lakh.

2. The Community wise **Physical allocation in** respect of your State Government/UT Administration under the scheme of Post-matric Scholarship for students belonging to minority communities alongwith **Time line** for the financial year 2012-13 is enclosed herewith (**Annex I & II**). The State Government/UT Administration is requested to publish the advertisement inviting applications for the year 2012-13 in April 2012 and adhere to the Time line with regard to submission of proposals to this Ministry. The **detailed format** alongwith **revised checklist** for submission of proposal by the States/UTs to Ministry of Minority Affairs is also enclosed at **Annex-III & IV**.

3. It is expected that from the financial year 2012-13 many areas of the country will have Unique Identification (UID) Scheme rolled out. However, all areas of the country will not have the benefit of the UID Number. It has been decided that from 2012-13 onward in the application form of Post-matric scholarship scheme, there would be a field to capture UID Number. The filling up of this number will however not be mandatory in 2012-13. The students may, however, be advised; wherever UID Number are known it would be in their own interest to quote the number.


4. States/UT Administrations are already aware of the fact that OSMS is being introduced from the year 2012-13. This site is accessible through URL www.momascholarship.gov.in. A link to the site has also been made available in the website of Ministry i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in.
5. As per para no. 14 of the Post-matric Scholarship, Scheme will be announced by the concerned State Government/ UT Administration well in time, through advertisements in the leading language newspapers and local dailies and by using other suitable public media. Accordingly, State / UT is requested to publish advertisements inviting application for the year 2012-13 by April 2012 and adhere to the **Time Lines** given in Annex-II with regard to various activities related to submission of proposal to this Ministry. The State Governments/UT Administrations may also advertise the scheme through other means and media as it may deem fit for wide publicity.
6. The State Governments /UT Administrations are also requested to mention in the advertisement about the online system and inform applicants in detail about the website including the address of the website i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in. The timeline of activities desirable for students may also be advertised. Applicants may also be advised to take printouts of the duly filled-in application forms, through OSMS, and to submit the same along with all supporting documents through their respective Schools/Colleges/Institutes to the State/ UT Department. It may be highlighted that without receipt of hard copy in the State/UT Department, the application is likely to be rejected. In the advertisement, attention of the students may also be invited to the FAQs, for filling up of online application, available on the homepage of the website of this Ministry.
7. While submitting the proposals, all terms and conditions contained in the Scheme are required to be followed. It may also be ensured that proposals are submitted along with Utilization Certificate in GFR-19A.
8. The State Governments/UT Administrations are also advised to furnish the status of disbursement of Scholarships released in the year 2011-12 to this Ministry. States/UTs are required to upload the list of students who have been awarded scholarships along with requisite detail on their website. Many States/UTs have already done this and hyperlinks to those sites are available on the website of the Ministry viz., www.minorityaffairs.gov.in . Publishing/ uploading the list of scholarship awardees on the website of Ministry of Minority Affairs is being made mandatory from this year i.e. those States/UTs who do not upload the list of students who have been awarded scholarships in 2011-12 on their website shall not be considered for release of scholarships in 2012-13.
9. It is once again requested to give wide publicity to this scheme so that minority community students are able to avail maximum benefit of the scholarship scheme.


