- 3. The various agriculture inputs like seed, fertilizer, growth hormones, farm implements, plants etc. are given to farmers either free or in subsidized rates under various UT Plan Schemes. 494 Farmers are benefited under various scheme/programmers.
- 4. The department has distributed about 11,000 coconut sapling to farmers of Daman District at free of costs as a part of its efforts to extend socioeconomic benefits of plantations to the people of Daman in general & the Farmers in particular..
- 5. The department has conducted study tour programme visit to high tech Floriculture green house in Bardoli, 112 Farmers are benefited under Extension & Farmer Training scheme.
- 6. Under Centrally Sponsored Scheme "Macro Management of Agriculture" the farmers are given the subsidies for purchase of Power tillers, agricultural tools, etc. Seven Farmers have been given benefit under the scheme.
