

**U.T. ADMINISTRATION OF DAMAN & DIU**  
**ACHIEVEMENTS & ACTIVITIES UNDER MAJOR**  
**DEVELOPMENTAL SCHEMES**

**(For the month of August 2014)**

The Union Territory Administration is committed towards providing an inclusive development to the population residing in the territory. A number of schemes for creation and upgradation of physical infrastructure and towards improving the socio-economic status of the citizens are being implemented by the U.T. Administration. The progress in this regard during the month of August, 2014 is highlighted below.

**A. Progress under Infrastructural Developmental Works :**

**(i) New Major Works started during the month of August, 2014:**

- Foundation Stone for Construction of **New Bridge at Tad Creek**, Diu at a cost of Rs. 9.5 Crore was laid down by **Hon'ble Minister of State for Home Affairs**, Govt. of India on 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2014.
- Foundation Stone for Construction of Aadiwasi Bhavan in Moti Daman area at a cost of Rs. 2.5 Crore on 8<sup>th</sup> August.

**(ii) Major Works completed during the month of August, 2014:**

- The **Hon'ble Minister of State for Home Affairs**, Govt. of India inaugurated **Cycle Track** from Nagoa junction to Malala junction at Diu on 3<sup>rd</sup> August, 2014 which was completed at a cost of Rs. 2.00 Crore.
- Construction of office building in place of Old dilapidated structure for Electricity Department, Nani Daman has been completed at a cost of Rs. 98.00 lakh and dedicated to the public on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 by Hon'ble Administrator.
- Construction of 30 bedded Hospital and component separate unit at Government Hospital, Marwadhas been completed at a cost of Rs. 93.00 lakh and inaugurated by Hon'ble Administrator on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2014.

- Construction of 4 Nos. of **Additional Class rooms** on ground floor for Govt. Higher Secondary School at Bucharwada, Diu including rain water harvesting has been completed at a cost of Rs. 61.00 lakh.
- **Replacement of RCC slab** on South Wing for Govt. Higher Secondary School, Diu has been completed at a cost of Rs. 39.00 lakh.
- Special repairs & improvement to Commerce building & Biology building at the Govt. College, Nani Daman has been completed at a cost of Rs. 31.00 lakh.
- **Development and Beatification** of Dholar Junction on Daman – Bamanpuja Road, Moti Daman has been completed at a cost of Rs. 28.00 lakh.

**B. Progress under Individual beneficiaries Oriented Schemes during the month of August, 2014:**

A number of schemes for the benefit of individuals are being implemented by the Administration, in which assistance in cash/kind is being provided by way of scholarship, pension, subsidy, loan, advances etc. The progress in this regard in various sectors during the month of August, 2014 is as follows:

➤ **Agriculture**

- Organic Fertilizer / Manure has been distributed to the **140 Nos.** of SC/ST/Small and Marginalized (**SM**) farmers on 100% subsidy.
- Fertilizer has been distributed to the **37 Nos.** of SC/ST/SM farmers on 50% subsidy.
- 24 Nos. of Coconut Plants has been distributed to the 06 Nos. of SC/ST/SM farmers on 100% subsidy.
- Storage bin set (**10beneficiaries**) and Sprayer Pumps (**06 beneficiaries**) has been distributed to SC/ST/SM farmers on 50% subsidy.
- Tools / Implements set (**07 beneficiaries**) and Agriculture machineries like paddy thresher (**2 beneficiaries**) has been distributed to SC/ST/SM farmers on 50% subsidy.

➤ **Crop Husbandry**

Tractors facility has been provided to 2 farmers on subsidy for Agriculture operations.

➤ **Animal Husbandry**

Subsidy provided to **32 women beneficiaries**(Rs. 7.68 lakh) under the Integrated Dairy Development Project.

➤ **Education**

Provided nutritious food to about **9752 students** (Std.I to VIII) under Mid-Day Meal scheme.

➤ **Health**

Financial assistance released for a total of Rs.75,000/- to **15 Mothers** under MatruSamrudhi Yojana (MSY) scheme @ Rs.5000/- to each beneficiary.

➤ **ICDS**

- Provided **nutritious food** to 6562 Children (06 months to 06 years).
- Provided **Food grain** to 1731 pregnant women & lactating / nursing Mothers.
- Provided **nutritious food** to 2016 Adolescent Girls – School Going.
- Provided **nutritious food** to 309 Adolescent Girls – Out of School.

**C. Organisation of important Events during the month of August, 2014:**

➤ **Sports**

- **Festival Tournament** – 2014-15 was organised on the occasion of Nariali Purnima in which following Sports activities were carried out:
  - (i) Open Beach Volleyball was organized from 8<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 at Jampore, Moti Daman.
  - (ii) “Tug of War” Tournament was organized on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 at Fort Area, Nani Daman.
- Daman District Inter School “**Subroto Mukerjee Cup**” final Football Tournament-2014-15 was organized on 21<sup>st</sup> August, 2014 for boys of under 14 & 17 years.

- Daman District Inter School **Chess & Carom**(Under- 14, 17 & 19 Boys & Girls) was organised from 20<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2014 at Bal Bhavan Office, Moti Daman. Badminton (Under- 14 Boys & Girls) was also organised on 26<sup>th</sup> August, 2014.

➤ **Bal Bhavan**

- Bal Bhavan, Daman has organised various cultural programmes on the occasions of **Narial Purnima Festival- 2014** in which following activities were carried out:
  - (i) “**Dance Daman Dance**” was organised on 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 at Vivekananda auditorium.
  - (ii) **Auditions** of singing and instrumental competition was organised on 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 at Vivekanand auditorium.
  - (iii) The **Finale** of Dance, Singing and instrumental competitions was organised on 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 at Vivekanand auditorium.
  - (iv) **Mehendi, Puja Thali, Boat making, Skit** and **extempore** competition was organised on 9<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 at Bal Bhavan.

About 11,000 children were participated in above competitions.

- Cultural Programme was performed by artist of West Zone Cultural Centre and local artists on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 i.e. Day of Narial Purnima. About 70 artists from Rajasthan, Assam, Punjab and Jharkhand were participated in this Cultural Programme.
- Various Cultural Programmes were organised on 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 in which about 120 children were participated in song & dance performance.

➤ **Agriculture**

Three days training programme of farmers was organised at Kachigam Farm.

**D. Other Important Activity (in brief).**

- The Hon’ble State Minister of Tourism & Culture **Shri Shripad Naik** has inaugurated the “**Brand Logo**” of Tourism of Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli in the presence of Hon’ble State Minister of Home Affairs Shri Kiren Rijju, Hon’ble Administrator Shri B. - The Hon'ble Administrator, UTs of Daman & Diu and Dadra & Nagar Haveli has opened **Tourism Vision 2020** in before representative of Electronic and Print Media at Mumbai on 9<sup>th</sup> August 2014. All the senior level officers of UTs of Daman & Diu and DNH were present in the function.
- The Hon'ble Administrator inaugurated the “**Saarthi Bus Sewa**” (Public Transport Services) for Daman on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 in presence of Hon'ble MP Shri Lalubhai B. Patel and leaders of Local Bodies.
- The Hon'ble Administrator inaugurated the **Saral Sewa Kendra** at District Panchayat, Daman on 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2014. The Saral Sewa Kendra will provide public related services on daily basis by using Information Technology.

- **Hindi Pakhavada** was inaugurated on 27<sup>th</sup> August, 2014 at Daman. During the Pakhavada various competitions has been organised to promote official language.

- Bank Accounts were opened under **PradhanMantri Jan Dhan Yojana**. A function was organised at community Hall, Dunetha in which Hon'ble Member of Parliament and Development Commissioner has distributed the ATM Card to the beneficiaries on 28<sup>th</sup> August.
- Financial bid for consultancy work of Under Ground Sewerage System for Nani Daman area has been opened and submitted to Competent Authority for approval.
- Financial bid for Solid Waste Management System for Daman District has been opened and submitted to Competent Authority for approval.
- A team of Ministry of Earth Sciences visited Diu for inspection the site for construction of **World Class Oceanarium**.
