

19. GOVERNMENT COLLEGE.

A . A brief description about Government College, Daman.

Since its inception in 1966 the Government College, Daman being the only college in this Union Territory for the undergraduate students of general stream (Science, Arts and Commerce) has been playing a pivotal role in meeting the demand of imparting quality higher education and in helping the students to achieve all round development.

Located at a serene and captivating sight, just 4 km away from the city, between Daman Vapi and Daman-Kunta roads, the College is easily accessible by roads. Its sprawling campus, exquisite buildings, airy and spacious class-rooms add to its charm.

The College has highly qualified, dedicated and motivated faculty (recruited through UPSC on All India Basis) who are constantly associated with the practical needs and problems of the students.

The college is having facility of co-education and though the medium of instruction is basically English teachers of this college do take extra pain in explaining the things in the language majority of students can understand.

The excellent infrastructure of the college, which includes a well-stocked library with 30,000 plus books in difference languages and on different subjects, journals, magazines audio-visual aids and spacious reading rooms ; well equipped laboratories of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Zoology : internet facilities for one and all ; boys hostel inside campus; decent play ground ; well designed Auditorium of 700 seating capacity with all modern amenities and other such things provides a very Conducive academic environment. 19. I - SETTING STANDARDS, PERFORMANCE MONITORING AND REMEDIAL MECHANISM:

For different projects the following system has been evolved and will be enforced to set standards, time limit, performance monitoring, achieve goals and remedial mechanism :

I - DEGREE/DIPLOMA RELATED PROJECTS:

A Committee will be constituted consisting of 3 senior faculty members from all the three faculties .

The committee will be chaired by the Principal of the college.

The Committee will meet on monthly basis to decide modus operandi, set standards and time limit to achieve performance and goals.

The committee members will pursue and coordinate with the officials of the different University and agencies as per requirements.

II - SPORTS & CULTURAL ACTIVITIES RELATED PROJECTS:

'The Students' Representative Council (SRC) consisting of some teaching faculty members and Students representatives from all the classes will be formed after the election of Students representatives as per the schedule of the south Gujarat University, Surat. The Counsel is chaired by the Principal of the College.

The counsel will meet as and when required and decide the schedules of sports and cultural activities in consultation with the sports committee.

One sports committee has been constituted to decide and coordinate the sports activities.

III - HOSTEL RELATED PROJECTS:

This committee will be chaired by the Principal of the college and existing Rector of the M. G. Boys Hostel. It will decide the Requirements and set standards for achievements.

IV - CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT PROJECT:

- 1.This Committee will consist of one senior Faculty member each from Arts, Science and Commerce.
- 2.The committee will be chaired by the Principal of the college.
The committee will meet as and when required.
3. The committee will coordinate with concerned officials as per requirement.

V – INFRA-STRUCTURE RELATED PROJECTS:

1. The decision about projects to be taken up/will be taken up and the officials of the PWD will be approached to construct various buildings as per requirements.

VI - QUALITY EDUCATION RELATED PROJECTS:

- 1 Head of departments of all the faculties , i.e. Arts, Science and Commerce will be asked to submit their requirements.
- 2 In meeting of H.O.Ds Chaired by the Principal of the College, All the requirements will be discussed and will be finalized.
- 3 Purchase committee of the college will be asked to work on Procurement of the requirements in time bound manner.
- 4 A committee consisting of three faculty Faculties members will be constituted for setting of Class –Rooms and preparing time table of the College.
5. A committee consisting of three faculty members including the Sports Teacher will be formed to look after and maintain discipline in the college.
