TENDER NOTICE

Daman & Diu Police, UT Administration of Daman & Diu, intends to install and set up IP based CCTV based surveillance and monitoring system in 06 check-posts / entry exit points and Police Head Quarters of Daman District have selected for implementation.

Daman & Diu Police, UT Administration of Daman & Diu, invites Bid from reputed and experienced Companies/ Consortia to participate in competitive tendering for providing CCTV based security and surveillance system in police station premises for Daman & Diu Police with default on-site warranty. The system suggested should comprise of the following core components:

- a) CCTV cameras- 4 Fixed/Bullet IP based outdoor cameras- all to be IR and audio enabled;
- b) NVR for 30 days Data storage and retrieval system and networking equipments at respective locations of installation.
- c) Display, viewing of all cameras in duty room on 15.6" screen,
- d) To make the live video feed available on the laptop, desktop or mobile phones of concerned officers on due authorization and authentication.

The purpose of CCTV project is to safeguard public areas of police stations, to see the movement of vehicles and to ensure that the security personnel deployed are regularly checking all the vehicles entering and exiting from Daman District. Installation of the CCTV cameras at the check-posts would help in keeping a watch on such anti-social elements and vehicles fled away un-noticed from the check-posts. Generally in each point there would be 4 bullet cameras focusing on the main entry / exit gate of the check post.

Firstly Video feed recording shall be done at each respective location. Live Video feed should be visible on the video display unit in the entry/exit check post. The video storage, retrieval and analysis system with separate video display unit should preferably be installed at Check post and at Police Head Quarters Daman for the cameras installed at PHQ, Daman.

The system shall be designed in such a manner that this video feed is capable to be transmitted in real time to the respective City PCR through connectivity over broadband or any other type of connectivity. The transmission medium and mode is to be decided later.

The bidder has to provide the complete solution including servers, storage, Video Management Software, network accessories, **Tender Document for Supply, Installation, Testing, and Commissioning of IP based CCTV cameras at PHQ and**


check-posts/ entry and exit points of the Daman District. Electric and electronic components and sub components required cabling for each check-posts/ entry and exit points and PHQ of the Daman District, which can be capable enough to integrate all the locations of the city at its respective Police Control Room.

Sealed Tenders are invited by the Dy. Superintendent of Police, Police Head Quarters, Airport road, Nani Daman, Daman – 396 210 on behalf of the President of India from experienced and reputed Manufacturer/Vendors/ authorized Dealers, Bidders. firms engaged in Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of CCTV Cameras and surveillance system having a minimum three year experience in the field, for the Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of CCTV Cameras and surveillance system along with its accessories/equipment/software/hardware if any, for the Police Department Of Daman & Diu for the following item :-

## OPENING OF BIDS AND PROCEDURE OF EVALUATION

1. Tender methodology proposed to be adopted by the Police Department of Daman & Diu will be "TWO Bid systems" i.e. **Technical Bid and Commercial Bid** (simultaneous receipt of separate technical and financial bids) with Technical bid containing prequalification.
2. During the opening of Technical Bid the authorized representative of the bidder may remain present if they so desire. The Bidders' representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance.
3. The Committee then would go through documents submitted by the Bidder and satisfy itself about the eligibility of the Bidders.
4. The Purchaser, Daman & Diu Police Department, reserves the rights to analyze the deviation and select the vendor accordingly. Minor deviations in technical specifications of inconsequential nature which do not affect the performance and longevity of the system / solution may be permitted by the Technical Committee while evaluating bid at appropriate time.
5. The Competent Authority or Purchase Committee may conduct clarification meetings with each or any Bidder to discuss any, technical matter.
6. Financial Bids of only Technically Acceptable Bidders shall be opened. Rest of the Bids shall not be considered. At the time of the opening of Financial Bids, Authorized Representatives may remain present. ***It shall not be obligatory to accept only the lowest Financial Bid.***
7. Any effort by the Bidder directly or indirectly to influence the Authority in the process of evaluation of Bids, Bid comparison or the Authority's decisions on acceptance or rejection of Bids may result in rejection of the Bidder's Bid.
8. *Superintendent of Police, Daman shall be the final Authority regarding any matter in relation to this Tender.*

## PAYMENT TERMS

1. The payment will be made only after the vendor has installed complete system and video feeds start recorded as per the timeline and the installation has been approved by the department and have functioned as per agreement and after completion GO-Lives of all sites.
2. Certificate from Bidder mentioning that service/support shall be available till the expiry of contract period from all OEMs. No change has been done in the earlier submitted original OEM authorization/support certificate. The on-site warranty and service support will stand as per the original OEMs certificate.

## CONFIDENTIALITY

1. The Bidder, their partners, suppliers, associates and their personnel shall not, at any time either during implementation or after completion of the project and further during operation and maintenance of the project, collect, compile, record, store, copy, forward or disclose in any manner any proprietary or confidential or personal information relating to the services, Agreement, the Daman & Diu Police's official data or information / data being recorded into the systems without

the prior consent and authority of the Competent Authority. Bidder and its personnel shall not disclose any information stored in the servers of the system to any person on any ground except with the express permission of competent authority unless it is legally required as per direction of court of competent jurisdiction. For any breach of confidentiality the bidder organization shall be responsible under all civil and criminal law in addition to the personal liability of the person indulging in such misconduct.

### **ADVICE TO THE BIDDERS**

1. Bidders are advised to study this tender document carefully before participating. It shall be deemed that submissions of Bid by the Bidder have been done after their careful study and examination of the tender document with full understanding as to its implications.
2. Bidders are also advised to ascertain whether they meet the eligibility criteria of the Bid.
3. The bidder must examine the technical specifications carefully and in case of any doubt should get those clarified from the Purchaser well in time preferably during pre bid meeting.
4. Bidder are advised to not to quote multiple (Original equipment of Manufacturer) OEMs and models for single item of Bill of Quantity. Only one specific make/model/part number compliant to specifications for one item should be quoted preferably.
5. The Bidder shall quote for all the components required for the complete solution inclusive of any other required components other than mentioned in (bill of Quantity) BOQ to complete the solution. The deviation in the BOQ shall be included in the Technical Bid.

### **SCOPE OF WORK**


Scope of work includes survey, design, site preparation, supply, installation, Commissioning and Maintenance of CCTV based Security and Surveillance Scope System for 06 Check posts / entry exit Points, 01 Police Head Quarters of Daman District.

#### ***Scope of the work includes:***

1. Carry out the feasibility study along with techno-commercial survey of sites identified for deployment of CCTV solution at respective police stations/Outpost.
2. Design, provide, Supply, Standard Installation, and testing of all project deliverables as per requirement defined in the document.
3. Site Acceptance Test
4. Final acceptance test
5. The minimum specified scope of work to be undertaken by the Selected Bidder is to be performed as per the specifications and conditions mentioned in the different parts of this document, any further amendments issued in this regard and the contract to be signed by the Successful Bidder subsequently. Operation

replaced by the bidder/supplier at his own cost, including the cost of transport. Bidder's/supplier's hardware engineer will report at the Police Head Quarters, Daman within 05 hours of reporting of breakdown through telephone/ email or fax or courier at the Bidder's/supplier's nearest office and repairs the same at the earliest.

2. The Bidder shall install, integrate, commission, implement and provide maintenance support for the equipment / software supplied to Daman & Diu Police. The equipment / software shall be covered under **default warranty available with the product (inclusive of replacement of OEMs spares)**. This service shall be provided **24x7 and on all days** to keep the supplied equipment / software in good working condition. The warranty shall commence from the date of system declared 'go live' at check-posts/ entry and exit points and PHQ of the Daman District.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT  
CHAPTER 2 of Rule 168 of GFR – 2017

(These terms and conditions are generic in nature, which have been mentioned for the knowledge of the bidders and bidders are advised to read carefully before submitting their bid(s))

1. This is an invitation to Bidders for setting up IP CCTV based security & surveillance system in 06 check-posts / entry exit points and Police Head Quarters of Daman District with complete accessories and all required hardware and software as per the Scope of Work and Technical Specifications mentioned in this Tender Document.
2. It will be imperative on each Bidder to fully acquaint itself with all the local sites, conditions and factors, which would have any effect on the performance of the contract and cost of the goods and services. No request for the change of price or time schedule of delivery of Goods and services shall be entertained, on account of any local condition or factor once the offer is accepted by the Police Department of Daman & Diu, the purchaser.
3. Sealed offers prepared in accordance with the procedures enumerated in this Tender Document should be submitted to Dy. Superintendent of Police, Police Head Quarters, Airport road, Nani Daman, Daman – 396 210, not later than the date and time laid down, at the address given in the succeeding paragraphs of this Tender Document.
4. Bidders must quote for complete quantities of items/services mentioned in the schedule of requirement. Bidders should quote for all the items/services mentioned, to satisfy functional and technical requirement of project in as mentioned in this Tender Document. Bids with partial response are liable to be rejected summarily.
5. The police stations where CCTV cameras will be installed are as mentioned in **APPENDIX-1**, after the survey depending upon the building size of Police station, the number of cameras and other items may change. Hence the Bidder shall quote unit wise rates so that additional work order for additional items may be issued if required.
6. The requirement mentioned in this tender document calls for a complete working system and not components thereof. Therefore, the Bids must be complete with all equipment and required accessories along with the entire equipment. video connectors, patch connectors, patch leads, LCDs, mounting and fitting hardware,

plugs, sockets and any hardware/software, etc. as required for complete installation & commissioning of the System under this contract.


7. The System should facilitate viewing of live and recorded images and controlling of all cameras by the authorized users. System should provide interoperability/ seamless Integration of hardware, Operating System, software, networking, printing, database connectivity, reporting, and communication protocols. At no later stage bidder will have the option to suggest any procurement on ground of any item or its spares being proprietary in nature unless specifically mentioned in the bid and highlighted during proof of concept (PoC).
8. The bidder has to prepare and install the cameras, hardware's/ software's /systems for all weather conditions.
9. The cameras should be enough to work withstanding wind, rainfall, hailstorm and other inclement weather conditions.
10. All video data has to be temper-proof, secure from eavesdropping, date, time and camera location stamped and watermarked. Data security and data integrity are at the core of the project as the feed may be called as evidence before any court, judicial, quasi judicial, commission or any other authority. Retrieved video must have date, time and camera location stamped.
11. The Bidder shall provide the requisite fixtures, fittings, and other items required for each location. All the fittings, wiring and cabling should be not left open except where the same is inevitable. Bidder may use existing electricity connection of police premises wherever required.
12. The Successful Bidder must not bid/supply any equipment that is likely to be declared end of life/sale within default warranty time period from the date of installation and commissioning the CC-TV camera System. The Bidder would be required to replace all such equipment with latest and at least of equivalent configuration during project duration.
13. Cameras, , switches, video display units, Network based digital recording system etc should be from a reputed manufacturer which can be integrated to any other manufacturer's Hardware-Software. The vendor should submit the confirmation of these conditions in OEM's letterhead whenever need arises the same shall be integrated without any interfacing problems. The expenditure for any interfacing related software / hardware requirement to complete the solutions shall be borne by the Bidder.
14. The required networking equipment for end to end connectivity shall also be provided by the Bidder at each location.
15. Although all care have been taken to provide detail BOQ of the goods and services but looking to the scope of the work there may be a possibility that this BOQ may not fully satisfy the functional and technical requirements outlined in this Tender Document. Bidder must clearly understand functional and technical requirements and must propose such additional hardware, software, networking,



- connectivity etc. and services which even though not specifically mentioned in BOQ but may be required to fully comply with functional and technical requirements. No additional payment would be made for supply and commissioning of goods and services etc. for such goods and services if not quoted in the bid but later bidder had to provide as per scope of work.
- 16 Tenders with price variation clauses or with vague terms are liable to be ignored and rejected summarily. Counter offers shall not be considered. Incomplete tenders are liable to be rejected.
  - 17 The Bidder should have a representative office within 200 Km radius from Daman. Addresses and contact details of the same should be provided. However, if local presence is currently not available within 200 Km radius, the Bidder must give an undertaking for establishment of an office within 200 Km radius capable and well equipped for supporting services required for the project within one month of award of the contract.
  - 18 The commercial /price bid shall includes all levies/ taxes like Service tax, VAT, Sales Tax, Transportation, Customs, Excise, traveling charges, support service during warranty etc. All other Taxes/Duties/Royalties charges payable on the Sale/Transport etc. within and/or outside the State/UT, of Supplier shall be payable by the supplier. No extra charges for packaging, forwarding and insurance etc. will be paid on the rates quoted in the commercial /price bid.
  - 19 CCTV camera System shall be install and functioning within Four (04) weeks from the date of supply order at Police Head Quarters, Daman.
  - 20 in case of failure to supply of **CCTV Camera System** ordered for, as per conditions and within the stipulated time period i.e 04 weeks, the same articles will be obtained, if required, from the bidder who has offered next higher rates (L2) or from any other source, as may be decided by the Purchase Committee and loss to Government on account of such purchase(s) shall be recovered from the former (L1) bidder's Performance Security Deposit / Earnest Money or bills payable. Such former (L1) bidder's shall have no any right to dispute with such procedure.
  - 21 The Purchase Committee of Police Department, reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid, and to annul the Bidding process and reject all Bids at any time prior to placing of purchase order without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for the Purchase committee's action.
  - 22 The Purchase Committee of Police Department may, at its sole discretion, waive any minor infirmity, nonconformity in a Bid which does not constitute a material deviation, provided such a waiver does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any Bidder.
  - 23 The Bidder is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specification in the Bidding Document. Failure to furnish all required information may result in the rejection of its Bid.

24. The bid should be quoted only for the items of given specifications confirm to the standard(s) requirements of the given specification/mark. Rates quoted for items other than required technical specifications/mark mentioned in the schedule, will not be considered. However indigenous manufacturers may quote their own makes provided that the technical specification confirmed to the standard(s)/requirement(s) of the given specification / mark.
25. Where this office does not specify name of the company/mark and rate should be quoted only for the first class and standard quality.
26. The supplied **CCTV camera System** should be supported for default comprehensive warranty period. Providing of warranty will be sole responsibility of the successful Bidder's/supplier's only.
27. *Tenders received without Earnest Money Deposit and Tender fee will be summarily rejected.*
28. The successful bidder will have to furnish an unconditional Performance Guarantee of an amount equivalent to 10% of contract value. The performance guarantee to be submits within 15 days after acceptance of supply order.
29. The amount of Performance Guarantee / Earnest Money deposits will be refunded after expiry of guarantee period if any, or any such date / period as may be mutually agreed upon or whenever Purchase committee deemed fit..
30. The E.M.D. Deposited by the bidder(s) will be returned to bidder(s), whose tender are not accepted.
31. The Earnest Money Deposits paid by the bidder against any other tender(s) is/are not adjustable with this tender.
32. The Purchase Committee will consider extension of the time for remitting the Performance Security Deposit as demanded. However, in case of denial to consider such extension, the successful bidder is bound and abides by the limit given.
33. The bidder should submit details of certificate, having a minimum three year experience in the field, for the Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of CCTV Cameras and surveillance system along with its accessories / equipment / software / hardware with govt. of private agencies.
34. **CCTV Camera System shall be installed** a ready to use condition along with all Cables, Connectors, Software Drivers, Hardware, Manuals and Media etc.
35. The **CCTV Camera System shall be installed** supplied should strictly conform and exactly as per the technical specifications mentioned in the schedule and shall also conform to the given product literature.
36. The supplies of **CCTV Camera System shall be installed** of different technical specifications or specified or incomplete or damaged **CCTV Camera System shall be installed** will not be accepted.
37. The supplier/ bidder will have to replace the **CCTV Camera System** at his own cost and risk on intimation of non-acceptance of any equipment/ materials / item,

- then the equipment/ materials / item will be sent to the supplier/ bidder within two weeks from the date of receipt in the stores and the same will have to be taken back by the suppliers at his own risk and cost.
38. In case, failure to replace the unaccepted & rejected articles from supplies made by supplier/ bidder as mentioned in the conditions, the loss undergone by the government will be recovered from the supplier's/ bidder's Performance Security Deposit / Earnest Money or payment due of any bill(s) to the extent required.
39. Extension of time limit for supplies may be considered by the Purchase Committee Daman provided that such request made well in time depending upon the circumstances and his decision in the matter will be final.
40. If any time after the order placed for installation of **CCTV Camera System**, Purchase Committee shall for any reason, what so ever, not required the whole or part of the quantity, where or has specified in the supply order, the Purchase Committee, Daman shall give notice in writing of the facts to suppliers who shall have no claim to any payment/compensation, what so ever on account of any profit or advantages, with suppliers might have derived in consequence of the full quantity of the articles, not having been purchased nor shall have any claim for compensation by reason of any alteration having been made in the original instructions, which shall involve any curtailment of the supply as originally contemplated.
41. All bills should be in triplicate and should invariably be mentioned the number and date of supply order.
42. All bills should be pre-receipted on a revenue stamp of proper value. Bills which are not pre-receipted on revenue stamp will not be accepted for payment.
43. Each bills in which Sales tax is charged must contain the following certificate on the body of the bill **"Certified" that the goods on which Sales Tax/VAT/Service tax has been charged have not been exempted under the C.S.T/VAT Act or the rules made there under and the amount charged on account of Sales Tax on these goods is not more than what is payable under the provision of relevant act of the rules made there under.**
44. All the legal matter pertaining to this tender will be handled & settled in Daman district jurisdiction only.
45. No Separate agreement will be required to be signed by the successful bidder for the purpose of the contract for supply **CCTV Camera System** on the rates mentioned in the commercial / price bid by the bidder.


