

INFORMATION ABOUT UIDAI AADHAAR ENROLMENT

This is to inform all residents of Daman and Diu that; the UT Administration has started the second phase of Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) enrolments for Unique Identification (UID) numbers, also called Aadhaar, in the UT of Daman & Diu.

AADHAAR ENROLLMENT CAMPS TIMING, WORKING DAYS & LAST DATE OF ENROLLMENT

In Daman & Diu district the enrolments are being performed in selective centers. The identified enrolment centers are as following:

- Education Hall, Near Jetty, Nani Daman, Daman.
- Daman Industrial Association Hall, Opp Somnath Temple, Somnath, Nani Daman.
- Bhimpore Group Gram Panchayat, Bhimpore, Nani Daman
- Office of the Collectorate, Collectorate, Dholar, Moti Daman
- Kachigam Gram Panchayat, Nani Daman, Daman.
- Vanakbara Panchayat, Diu
- Diu Municipal Council, Diu

TIMING & WORKING DAYS: The enrolment process of UID is from 09:00am to 07:00pm on all calendar days including Saturday, Sunday and Public holidays.

Free Enrollment: Enrollment for aadhaar card is **totally free** of cost. Enrolment forms are available free of cost at enrollment center.

Required Documents: Document required along with application form for UIDAI enrollment are: Proof of Identity (PoI), Proof of Address (PoA) and Date of Birth (DoB) proof. (if Not Available): People who do not have required documents i.e. address proof and Identity Proof can also apply for Aadhaar. Authorized individuals, who already have an Aadhaar, can introduce residents who don't possess any documents to establish their identity to enable them to receive their Aadhaar.

Aadhaar is for Everyone:

The Aadhaar Number / UID would be issued to every individual resident in India who satisfies the verification process laid down by the UIDAI, including NRIs, and foreigners residing in India. The physical presence in India for providing fingerprints and other bio-metrics etc. is necessary. Aadhaar UID doesn't establish citizenship and is not only for Indians.

Correction and Modification: Those residents who receive Aadhaar card with minor errors or require some modification, may modify the details by producing the valid proof for correction at the enrollment centers. Residents can also submit their updating requests online through the self-service update portal by logging to www.uidai.gov.in website, which will accept requests for changes in name, gender, date of birth, address and mobile number.

CHECK YOUR AADHAAR ENROLLMENT STATUS:

After the enrollment, your aadhaar card will reach to the address provided by you at the time of registration within 90 days. You can also check your enrollment status online on the official website of UIDAI by entering the 14 digit Enrollment number and 14 digit date and time on the acknowledgement slip. Residents of Daman & Diu who have registered and not received their Aadhaar card may check their status using above mentioned facilities. In case, Aadhaar card status is shown negative, residents may reenroll themselves in the enrolment centers listed above.

In the near future, this Aadhaar number is going to be integrated with various government schemes of various departments. So the UT Administration of Daman & Diu requests all individuals to get them enrolled along with their family members at the earliest, to utilize the facilities associated with the UIDAI AADHAAR project.
